

Science Stations
Developing the 5 Senses

1. Seeing: easy board books that allow parents/kids to talk about what is in the pictures and point

In this station, parents/children look at board books, talking about the pictures and colors, etc.

2. Hearing:

Hearing: Water bottles or baggies filled with beans or unpopped popcorn

In this station, parents/children keep a steady beat, or sing nursery rhymes while keeping a steady beat.

3. Touching: Play dough (edible)—give baggie of it to take home with recipe. There will also be Touchable Bubbles.

In this station, parents/children squish and mold with edible play dough. They can also catch bubbles.

4. Tasting: Sorting Goldfish and Cheerios

In this station, parents/children sort the snacks into piles of like items.

5. Smelling: have cotton balls that were dipped in different scents and dried for them to smell

In this station, parents/children smell the different cotton balls, and point to pictures as they talk about the smells.
