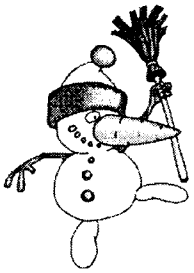




Vision Development Station Suggestions

- 5. Rattles for Grip and Visual Interest**

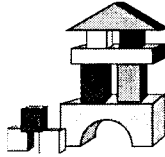
